In 1998, City Council initiated a Community Development Award program to recognize significant achievement in community development, highlight successful development ideas that others can use and inspire other projects to meet the standards set by successful projects.

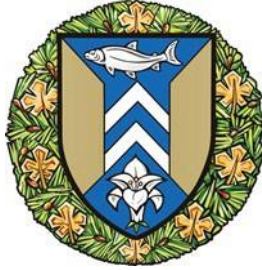
Every year – through the Community Development Award Committee – this award is presented to a local business or organization.

### **Criteria**

Community development is an all-encompassing term. Eligible projects may positively benefit the community in one or several of the following ways:

- Enhance the visual quality of the built environment;
- Pursue sustainable development and protect the natural environment;
- Promote equity and accessibility to a variety of people, income groups, and abilities;
- Maximize employment and earning opportunities; or
- Facilitate heritage preservation.

The winner of the Community Development Award will be presented with a bronze plaque at the City's annual Awards Ceremony.
