• There is a cancellation policy of two weeks prior to the booking.

• A **minimum of 10 people** are required to book a Heritage Culinary Experience. The maximum number we are able to accomodate is 36 people.

• All Heritage Culinary Experience bookings require a deposit of at least 4 sittings, including HST. This deposit is non refundable, but will be applied towards the overall booking fee. If the event needs to be rescheduled, the deposit will be transfered to the later date. If the event is cancelled, any money over and above the deposit will be refunded.

• Any and all decorations or altercations must be approved by the Curator or Assistant Curator of the Ermatinger Clergue • National Historic Site. Furniture and artifacts within the museum may not be moved or handled. Any damages occured must be covered by the booking party.

• The Ermatinger • Clergue National Historic Site is happy to provide regular parking, accessible parking, and bus bay parking for your convenience. Additional parking may be found and available on Queen Street as metered parking or in the Heritage Parking Lot with a 2 hour free limit.
