This commercial block was built in 1913 by druggist T. T. Barnes. Its late Edwardian style is reflected in its symmetrical façade and its use of classical motifs.

Elegant Craftsman style homes, whose design is influenced by the Prairie School as reflected in the low roof pitch, overhanging eaves, clerestory lighting and the use of rustic materials such as wood, stone, brick and stucco.
