PURPOSE

The applicant is seeking Council's approval to permit the subject properties to be utilized for additional parking in association with the existing autobody shop located at 252 Wallace Terrace.

PROPOSED CHANGE

The applicant, Victor Alfano, is requesting an Official Plan Amendment to redesignate the subject properties by way of a notwithstanding clause to the Residential policies, to permit the parking of vehicles in association with the autobody shop located at 252 Wallace Terrace.

The applicant is also requesting a rezoning from Low Density Residential Zone (R3) to Low Density Residential Zone (R3.S) with a special exception to permit the parking of vehicles upon the subject properties, in association with the autobody shop at 252 Wallace Terrace.

LEGAL NOTICE CONCERNING YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the City of Sault Ste. Marie before the By-Law is passed, the person or public body may not be entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of the City of Sault Ste. Marie to the Ontario Municipal Board.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting, or make written submissions to the City of Sault Ste. Marie before the By-Law is passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.
