

**TENDER – CONTRACT NO. 2019-9E
MISCELLANEOUS CONSTRUCTION/PAVING**

Sealed tenders, plainly marked as to contents, in the City of Sault Ste. Marie tender envelope provided, will be received by the City Clerk until **3:00 p.m. local time on Wednesday, June 5, 2019** for the construction of the works described below.

The work generally consists of supplying all materials, labour and equipment necessary for the resurfacing of Allen Side Road from Bruce Street to Trelawne Avenue; Pim Street from Summit Avenue to McDonald Avenue; Chapple Avenue from Willow Avenue to Allard Street; Manitou Drive from McNabb Street to Anna Street and Surface Treatment of various locations within the Municipality of Sault Ste. Marie.

Tender documents may be studied, but not removed without a deposit payment, at the Sault Ste. Marie Construction Association, 117 White Oak Drive East, Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario and the office of the City Engineering Department.

Complete tender documents, including tender forms and envelopes, may be obtained by general contractors commencing **WEDNESDAY, MAY 22, 2019** at the office of the City Engineering Department, 5th floor, Civic Centre, 99 Foster Drive, Sault Ste. Marie, upon payment of a \$100.00 refundable deposit, payable to the Corporation of the City of Sault Ste. Marie, for each set of contract documents. This deposit will be refunded if the documents are returned in good condition within fifteen (15 days) after the tender closing date.

Tenders must be accompanied with a tender deposit in the form of a certified cheque, money order, bid bond or bank draft in the amount of **10% of the Tender Price** payable to the Corporation of the City of Sault Ste. Marie.

A public opening of this tender will be held at **3:15 p.m. local time on Wednesday, June 5, 2019** in the Steelton Room, Level 3, Civic Centre, 99 Foster Drive.

Tenders are subject to a formal contract being prepared and executed. The Corporation of the City of Sault Ste. Marie reserves the right to reject any or all tenders and the lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted.
