General Information

All Commemorative Tree Sponsors will receive an Official Tax Receipt for your tax-deductible sponsorship. The City of Sault Ste. Marie will plant a single stemmed commemorative tree, which is native to Northern Ontario. The City of Sault Ste. Marie will securely install a 6" x 8" commemorative plaque at the base of the tree. All costs for the commemorative bronze plaque and tree, including planting, is to be paid at the prevailing rate to the City of Sault Ste. Marie. The City will provide the location for the tree to be planted. The City will guarantee the tree for two years. Commemorative trees will be ordered twice a year. Planting will occur during the months of May/June or September/October.
