The setting provides you with tables set with linens, and blue willow china. If the meal is served in the summer kitchen, then depending on the day, a fire in the hearth will be lit.

For any Heritage Culinary Experience we require a minimum of 10 people. The maximum number of people we can accommodate in the Summer Kitchen is 30.

All Heritage Culinary Experience bookings require a deposit of <u>4 meals</u> per event due at the time of booking. <u>This deposit is non-refundable</u>. If the event is rescheduled for a later date, we will transfer that deposit to the later date. If the event is cancelled more than two weeks before the booking, any money received over and above the deposit will be refunded.

Any decorations or alterations must be approved in advance by the Curator of the Ermatinger•Clergue National Historic Site. Furniture and objects belonging to the museum may not be moved or handled.

The Ermatinger•Clergue National Historic Site has regular parking, accessible parking and bus bay parking off of 800 Bay Street. Additional parking may be available on Queen Street (metered parking) or in the Heritage Lot (2 hour free parking). Entrance to your culinary event is off Bay Street at the Heritage Discovery Centre (unless pre-arrangements made for Queen St. entrance).

The Ermatinger•Clergue National Historic Site is owned and operated by the City of Sault Ste. Marie. All City facilities are **smoke free**, **vape free**, **and cannabis free** as per City Bylaws.
