

The Dangerous Dog Committee hears appeals from dog owners who are served with a Notice of Dangerous Dog Designation and has the authority to confirm the determination of a dangerous dog or rescind or substitute the determination. The Committee's decision is final.

In accordance with section 5.2(2) of the *Statutory Powers Procedure Act* you may, by satisfying the Committee that holding this hearing as an electronic hearing is likely to cause you significant prejudice, require this hearing as an oral hearing.

If you do not participate in the hearing the matter may proceed without your participation and you will not be entitled to any further notice in the proceeding.
