1. I am qualified pursuant to the Regulation made under the *District Social Services Board Act* which outlines the qualifications of members and the term of office.
2. I am a Canadian citizen
3. On Nomination Day, August 21 2026 I will be at least 18 years of age.
4. I am a permanent resident of the territory without municipal organization, an owner or tenant of property in the territory without municipal organization, or the spouse of an owner or tenant of property in the territory without municipal organization.
5. I am not an employee of the DSSAB.
6. I am not a judge of any court.
7. I am not a member of the Assembly as provided in the Legislative Assembly Act or of the Senate or House of Commons of Canada or, if I am such a person, I will provide proof of my resignation in a form satisfactory to the Clerk of the City of Sault Ste. Marie prior to 2:00 p.m. on Nomination Day, August 21, 2026. I understand that the Clerk of the City of Sault Ste. Marie will reject my nomination for the above-mentioned office if I fail to provide proof of resignation by this deadline.
8. I do not hold more than one office, election of which is governed by the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* and/or the *District Social Services Administration Boards Act*.
9. I am not a public servant within the meaning of the *Public Service Act*, or if I am a public servant, I have followed and will continue to follow all the relevant provisions of Part V of such Act.
10. I am not prohibited from voting at the municipal election under subsection 17(3) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*.



- 11. I am not a person who is serving a sentence of imprisonment in a penal or correctional institution, including a sentence being served in the evenings or weekends.
- 12. A corporation.
- 13. A person who was convicted of the corrupt practice described in Subsection 90(3) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* if Voting Day in the current election is less than four years after Voting Day in the election in respect of which he or she was convicted.
- 14. A person who was convicted of the corrupt practice described in Subsection 91(1) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* if Voting Day in the current election is less than six years after Voting Day in the election in respect of which he or she was convicted.
- 15. A person disqualified for violations of financial requirements or violations of requirements for filing financial information.
- 16. Otherwise ineligible or disqualified under the *Municipal Act, 2001* or any other Act.
